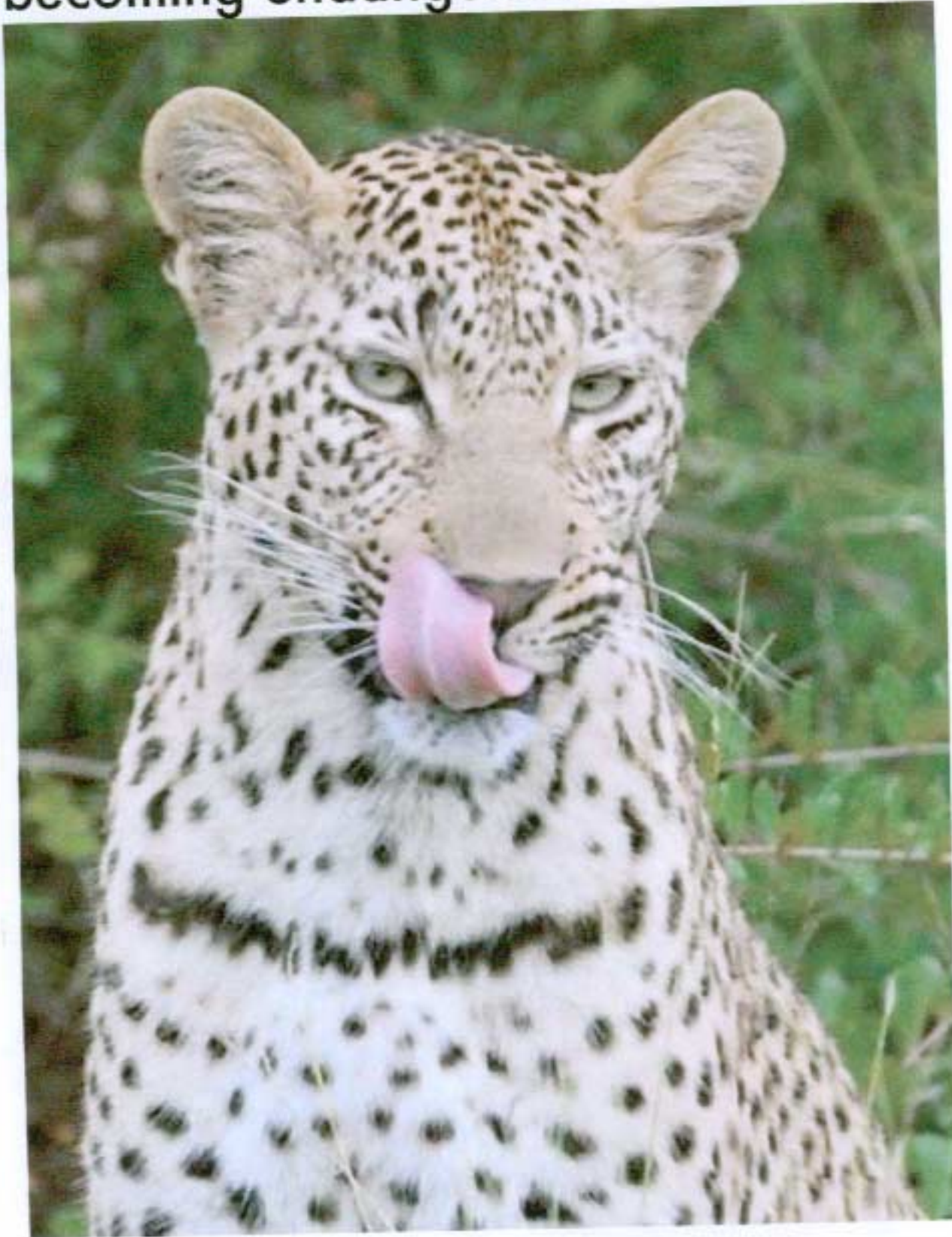
LION
